A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Joshua Moore on his outstanding public service; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Joshua Moore has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
4 role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the
5 citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service creating the first HIV positive law firm for Social
9 Security matters; and

10 WHEREAS, this adoptive father of five and foster parent has litigated numerous
11 precedent-setting cases for Social Security law in the Sixth Judicial Circuit, and his law firm
12 handles cases at all phases of the Social Security disability process; and

13 WHEREAS, in 2007, he helped create the National HIV/AIDS Project (NHADP),
14 headquartered in Atlanta, which advocates for people seeking disability benefits, adequate
15 housing in Atlanta, and quality medical services and transportation for people living with
16 HIV in Georgia; and

17 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high
18 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he possesses the vast wisdom
19 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
20 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

21 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
22 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

23 WHEREAS, Joshua has served with honor and distinction as an attorney and community
24 activist, and his vision and unyielding commitment to advocating for those who are living
25 with HIV have set the standard for public service; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
